However, this variety has since been severely affected by pests and diseases, leading to a drastic reduction in cane area in the Karur district. With the economic impact being significant, we had no choice but to scale down cultivation.

Thanks to EID Parry's R&D and cane teams, as they introduced the PI 08 238 variety, which is tolerant to these prevailing pests and diseases and delivers higher yields. With this new variety, we are hopeful of reviving sugarcane cultivation this year.

This amount is channelled through the AMM Foundation which proudly celebrates a century of service. AMMF focusses on healthcare, education, environment and sport needs of communities the Group operates in.

Over the last decade, the Group's focus areas have expanded to include sanitation & hygiene, skill development and community development.

Today, dedicated teams in each company implement CSR projects at the regional and national levels, working along with the Foundation and service partners.

AMM Foundation

Initiatives



In 2023-24, Healthcare, Education, Community Support, Environmental Conservation, Skill Development and Sport continued as the focus areas for CSR initiatives by the Group companies and the CSR Arm of the Group — the AMM Foundation.



Healthcare

- ◆ The 5 hospitals run by the AMM Foundation treated over 8.15 lakh patients.
- ◆ Through 6 mobile health vans offering services in various parts of the country, the Foundation recorded a total patient footfall of over 1,05,000.



Education

- ◆ The 5 educational institutions (four schools and a polytechnic college) run by the AMM Foundation catered to educational needs of 8,892 students, of which over 6,000 belong to marginalised communities.
- ◆ The AMM Murugappa Chettiar Centenary Scholarships (full fee) supported 445 Murugappa scholars.
- ◆ The Murugappa Science Centre covers about 119 government and government-aided schools in Sivaganga and Pudukkottai districts, reaching over 14,000 students.



Environment

- ◆ AMM Foundation established NANNEER (நன்னீர்), a water body rejuvenation project in Sivaganga, Pudukkottai, Tiruppur, Cuddalore and Erode.
- ◆ Under this project, 30 water bodies were rejuvenated and water capacity was increased by about 5 billion litres.



Sport

- ◆ The Murugappa Youth Football Academy (MYFA) has trained 600 boys since its inception.
- ◆ Through the Murugappa Raising Talent Sports Scholarship, the AMM Foundation is supporting 10 athletes of which 5 are para-athletes.

Company CSR Highlights

Healthcare



- ◆ EID Parry, through the project 'Wellness on Wheels', provided medical care facilities to 4 locations and 55,000+ people.
- ◆ EID Parry conducted specialised eye camps for rural populations, providing spectacles and cataract surgeries for over 5,000 villagers.
- ◆ TI India Medical Outreach Centre in Tiruttani saw patient footfall of 38,525 people.
- ◆ Coromandel International's medical centres, NICU/PICU initiatives, surgeries for children with congenital heart disease, and Coromandel Hospitals reached over 3,20,000 individuals.
- ◆ Coromandel has supported 100 Surgeries through Sathya Sai Sanjeevani trust for congenital heart surgery in 2024 and continue this support in 2025.
- ◆ At Kakinada, the expansion of the Coromandel Hospital advanced steadily, evolving from a modest outpatient facility into a soon-to-be 60-bed multispecialty hospital. New specialised operation theatres, a NICU, casualty care, and advanced diagnostic services moved closer to reality, promising a lifeline for 1,18,028 individuals directly.
- ◆ CUMI continued its support to Sri Sathya Sai Sanjeevani Hospitals in conducting paediatric cardiac surgeries, which benefited 21 children.
- ◆ Through The Energy and Resources Institute (TERI), CG Power and Industrial Solutions provided infrastructure support to Primary Healthcare Centres situated in Bamnai and Diwatiya villages in Madhya Pradesh benefiting 15,000 people every month.
- ◆ Chola provided free eye care through project RAAHI to 2,25,035 truck drivers across various Indian cities.

Company CSR Highlights

Education



- ◆ EID Parry provided scholarships worth ₹11.5 lakh for students from farming backgrounds.
- ◆ TI India contributed to building the higher secondary block at TI School, Chennai, through the AMM Foundation, benefiting 1,430 students. This block will have 3 classrooms, 2 labs and an auditorium with a seating capacity of 800.
- ◆ CUMI supported the AMOLED Research Centre at IIT, Madras, which aims to develop next generation AMOLED displays for smartphones, tablets, watches and wearables.
- ◆ CG Power and Industrial Solutions provided infrastructure facilities to Zilla Parishad/ Municipal Schools in Ahmednagar and Nashik. The schools were also provided with Interactive panels to enhance education.
- ◆ Chola awarded scholarships to 536 children of commercial vehicle crew members.
- ◆ Chola MS also contributed to the Vidyarambam Trust, Chennai towards infrastructure at the Vidyarambam schools in Nagapattinam, Tamil Nadu.

Company CSR Highlights

Environment/Community Support



- ◆ EID Parry continued to support rural infrastructure development by establishing RO Plants, desilting drinking water facilities and enabling villagers to access clean drinking water all year round.
- ◆ TI India has launched Project One Million Trees in 2024, with 4,448 trees planted so far.
- ◆ Through the Coroneer Project, which is functioning in all its locations, Coromandel International installed 34 RO plants and more than 10 borewells providing safe drinking water to over 1,05,026 people.
- ◆ The SEED Mangrove Plantation Project at Dahej by Coromandel International breathed new life into 25 hectares of coastal land, planting 62,500 saplings and supporting 214 local villagers with alternate income opportunities.
- ◆ CG Power and Industrial Solutions partnered with TERI for integrated rural development of communities for social development in and around Mandideep in Madhya Pradesh, distributed Integrated Domestic Energy Systems, benefiting 8,000 people in 6 villages.
- ◆ Chola's support continued for the rural and disadvantaged people in Odisha by providing purified drinking water to the villagers in a sustainable manner. 48 households were provided toilets with overhead tanks of 300 litres each, with supply of water through solar energy.
- ◆ CUMI made a grant to the Sri AMM Murugappa Chettiar Research Centre, Chennai for soil health management for sustainable agricultural practices.

Company CSR Highlights

Sport/Skill Development



- ◆ CUMI's Centres for Skill Development at Hosur and Kochi benefited over 96 students from underserved sections of the society.
- ◆ Through the Ahmednagar Auto and Engineering Association, CG Power and Industrial Solutions set up a skill development centre providing welding and winding training programmes.
- ◆ EID Parry enabled 200 young adults to receive specialised training in Pencak Silat, an Indonesian martial art and one of the 56 recognised sports in India. 4 of these young athletes participated in the 8th Senior Asian Pencak Silat Championship 2024, which took place in Tashkent, Uzbekistan, and clinched bronze medals for the nation.
- ◆ Chola provided skill training programmes in retail and allied sector as well as an auto driving programme to 251 women.
- ◆ Chola supported 108 national chess players, 8 golf players, 1 international wheelchair tennis player and 1 swimmer across India.
- ◆ 986 students have benefited from TI India's Skill Development Centre at Avadi. This centre provides training in seven different trades to youths from various districts of Tamil Nadu and nearby states.
- ◆ Over 400 youth and women were trained in tailoring, welding, digital literacy and other relevant local trades by Coromandel International across locations.
- ◆ The near completion of the Coromandel Empower Centre in Kakinada, a 4,800 sq. ft. facility, promises to become a vocational and entrepreneurship hub, with an investment of ₹75 lakh already made this year.
- ◆ CUMI contributed to Murugappa Raising Talent Sports Scholarship aimed at nurturing young athletes and empowering coaches from South India in sports such as badminton, tennis and para-athletics.

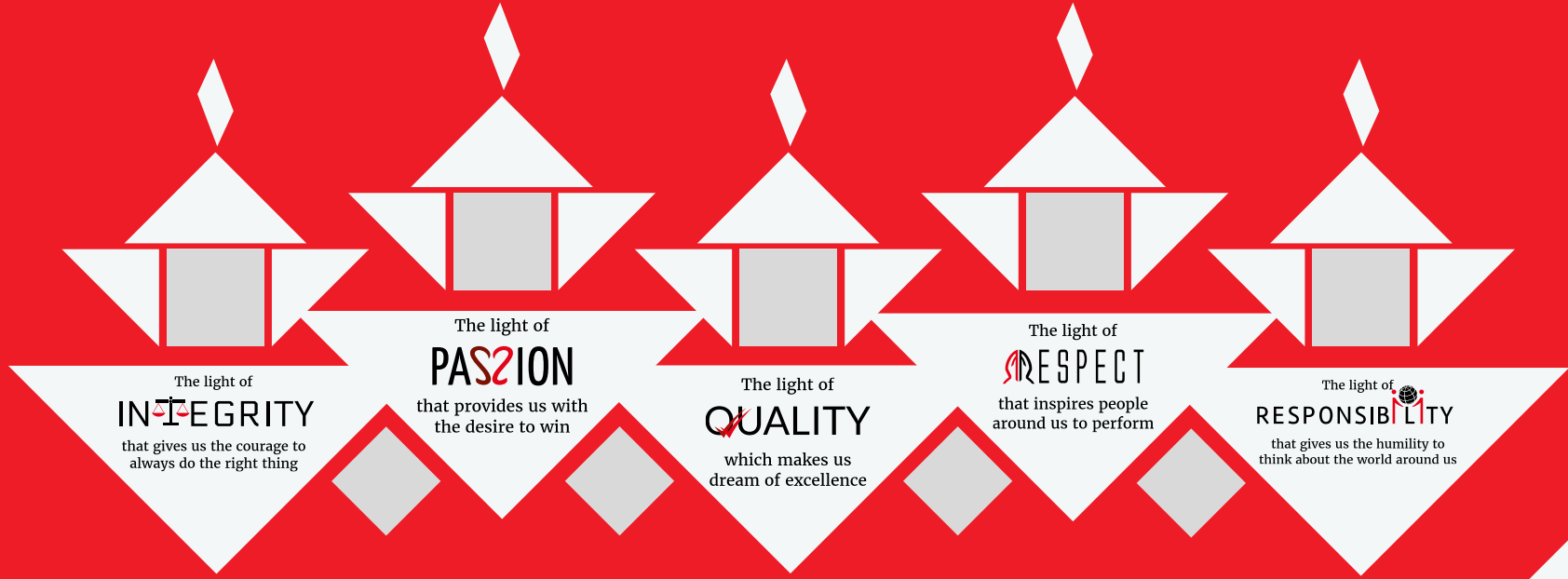


A birds' paradise at Coromandel's Kakinada plant

Once a marshy water-logged area, this plant has today transformed into a serene, lush green belt proving to be an ideal habitat for diverse species of birds while greatly contributing to biodiversity and conservation of the ecosystem.
